MINI GOLF - BEST SHOT RULES

Eligibility

All players must be regular employees (full or part-time), interns or retirees of companies registered for the Corridor Corporate Games.

General Rules

- 1. Companies are limited to two open teams. Mini golf will be played in best shot format.
- 2. 1 stroke per person per shot attempt.
- 3. Local scramble rules apply.
- 4. Tiebreakers will be determined based on best score from hole 17. If it is still tied, then hole 16, etc.
 - a. Hole 18 is a unique set-up. For this hole both teams will select one team member to tee off at the same time as the selected person from the opposing team. The first person to have their ball go in the cup receives 1 stroke for the hole. The other team receives 2 strokes.
- 5. Tee times will be assigned. Please arrive early. Please check-in 15-20 minutes before your tee time.
- 6. Please bring your own golf ball and putter to use. There will be a limited supply of golf balls and putters.

CCG Point System

 Medals will be awarded to the top three teams in each division. Points will be awarded to the top four teams within each division, as follows:

Place	Points
1 st	500
2 nd	400
3 rd	300
4 th	200
5 th	50
6 th	50

Participation points will be awarded to all teams in the CCG. To receive participation points, teams
must complete the event as designed. Points for participation per team in mini golf are as follows:
